Campus 2, 6 – 12th Grade, Standardized Dress Code
2007-08

****Dress code to be reviewed at the end of the 2007-08 school year. Revisions will be announced at orientation.****
Calvary Christian Academy has a “standard of dress” to ensure the neatness of its students and to allow students from all economic backgrounds the freedom to be themselves apart from the stress of competitive dress. Students are to be neat, modest, well groomed, and in designated clothing at all times during school hours. Students should dress modestly when attending activities on the school campus outside of school hours. The school reserves the right to ask a student to leave and change clothes if it determines the student’s dress to be immodest. This following “standard of dress” is specific to Campus 2.

All students

- ❖ **Pants** - navy blue, black or light tan/khaki (cotton – twill material, with or without pleats)
- ❖ **All pants, shorts, capris, skirts, skorts, or jumpers** must be made of cotton-twill material. They must be without rip or tear and in good repair
- ❖ **Polo Shirt** – short sleeve or long sleeve, with or without logo, with plain collar and at least 2 buttons - white, maroon, navy blue, light blue, pale pink, or light grey - must be plain and solid color
- ❖ **Dress Shirt (as described below) or Polo Shirt MUST be worn at all times**
- ❖ During colder seasons, a supplementary turtle neck, long sleeve polo, fleece, or sweater in an approved solid color is allowed. Sweaters and fleeces must be a solid color without print (store logo may not exceed 1.5” by 1.5” in diameter)
- ❖ Pants and shirt may not be oversized
- ❖ At no time should undergarments be visible – **this includes camisoles**
- ❖ Hats, sunglasses, pagers, and cellular phones may not be worn at any time

Male Students

- ❖ ***Dress Shorts** - navy blue, black, light tan/khaki, worn to the knee, appropriately sized, and in good repair. May be worn during the first two months and last two full months of school to accommodate for warmer weather
- ❖ All pants or shorts must be worn on hips or above
- ❖ **Belts** must be worn (brown, black, navy blue with a normal buckle without adornment)
 - Appropriate fitting belts with no excessive material
 - Pants and belt must be worn on hips or above
- ❖ **Dress Shirts** - white, or very light blue, must be plain and solid color (cotton – polyester blend, oxford style, long sleeved and ironed)
- ❖ Shirts must be tucked into pants

Female Students

- ❖ **Capri's** - navy blue, black, or light tan/khaki – past the knee without any material hanging from them – cotton – twill material, without rip or tear and in good repair
- ❖ **Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers** - navy blue, black or light tan/khaki – the shortest part of the skirt or slit must come to the top of the knee cap – cotton-twill material, without rip or tear and in good repair
- ❖ **Dress Shirts/Blouses** – short sleeve or long sleeve, white or very light blue, must be plain and solid color (no beads or sequins)
 - If the shirt contains tails, they must be tucked in
 - If the shirt bottom is cut straight across it does not need to be tucked in but it must be long enough to come to the middle of the hip
- ❖ No bare midriffs (if midriff shows when hands are raised, the shirt should not be worn)
- ❖ Polo shirts do not have to be tucked in for girls, but it is preferable
- ❖ Pants and shirt may not be tight fitting and chest must be appropriately covered

Exclusions (these items are NOT acceptable)

- ❖ Baggies, cargo, corduroy, denim, jersey knit, or tight fitting pants
- ❖ Hooded sweatshirts or hooded fleeces
- ❖ Healy's, flip flops, clogs and sandals
- ❖ Excessive wrinkles in clothing
- ❖ Any color outside of the approved colors
- ❖ Tattoos – students who choose to get a tattoo on a visible part of the body while enrolled at CCA will be subject to dismissal
- ❖ Body piercing – girls may wear up to 2 earrings per ear and boys may not wear any
- ❖ Outlandish hairstyles and hair color
- ❖ Boys hair that covers the ear completely, touches the collar or covers the face
- ❖ Changing into non-standard clothing while on school property unless directed by a teacher, coach, or administrator for a specific school related activity

Accessories / Trends

- ❖ On the above shirts mentioned, a store logo may not be larger than 1.5" by 1.5" in diameter
- ❖ Shoes are to be worn at all times on the school property. Tennis shoes, sneakers, tie shoes and loafers are acceptable. Healy's are NOT permitted. Dress style open-toed shoes are acceptable for 9th – 12th grade girls only (heels may not be higher than 2")
- ❖ Socks that are compatible and not clashing with the attire are acceptable
- ❖ Complementary and non-distracting jewelry for girls is acceptable
- ❖ Young men are to be clean shaven
- ❖ Long sleeve solid color shirts worn under shirts must fit into the standardized colors. However, two shirts with a collar on them cannot be worn at the same time
- ❖ The administration reserves the right to make changes and clarify statements as trends arise

Physical Education Attire

Tennis shoes/sneakers are required for Physical Education. It is also recommended that students wear the CCA grey PE t-shirt, or CCA retro logo t-shirt with (plain, solid colored) navy or grey shorts or sweat pants (with or without CCA PE logo). Navy, maroon, or grey athletic pants, with or without a stripe (stripe must be an approved CCA color) may also be worn. The shorts must be no more than 3" above the top of the knee cap
