

Elementary School Standardized Dress Code

1st - 5th Grades 2006 - 2007

Calvary Christian Academy has a “standard of dress” to ensure the neatness of its students and to allow students from all economic backgrounds the freedom to be themselves apart from the stress of competitive dress. The elementary school will have the same dress code as the Primary school with a few exceptions to allow for a more feasible dress for outdoor activity during recess and gym. While the Primary School dress code is preferred and encouraged for Campus I, we will allow the following exceptions for the elementary school.

Elementary School Boys and Girls ONLY

- ❖ **Shorts** - Navy Blue, Black or Khaki, same rules apply for shorts as the primary school rules for pants (see below)
- ❖ **CCA Logo T-shirts** - Navy Blue, Maroon, Light Grey or White, appropriately sized and in good repair
- ❖ **Blue Jeans and Jean Capris** - without rips or holes and in good repair may be worn with the CCA logo t-shirt or polo shirt

Male Students

- ❖ **Pants** - Navy Blue, Black or Light Tan Khaki (cotton, with or without pleats)
- ❖ **Dress Shirts** - White, or very Light Blue (cotton - polyester blend, oxford style, long sleeved and ironed)
- ❖ **Polo Shirt** - with collar and at least 2 buttons - White, Maroon, Navy Blue, Light Blue, Pale Pink, or Light Grey
- ❖ **Belts** must be worn (brown or black with a normal buckle without adornment)
 - ✓ Appropriate fitting belts with no excessive material
 - ✓ Pants and belt must be worn on hips or above
- ❖ Shirts must be tucked into pants
- ❖ Pants and shirt may not be oversized
- ❖ During colder seasons, a supplementary turtle neck, long sleeve polo, fleece, or sweater in an approved solid color is approved. Sweaters and fleece must be a solid color without print (store logo may not exceed 1.5” by 1.5” in diameter)

Female Students

- ❖ **Pants** - Navy Blue, Black or Light Tan Khaki
- ❖ **Capris** - Navy Blue, Black or Light Tan Khaki - past the knee for girls without any material hanging from them
- ❖ **Skirts, Skorts or Jumpers** - Tan (Khaki)- the shortest part of the skirt or slit must come to the top of the knee cap
- ❖ **Dress Shirts/Blouses** - White or very Light Blue (no beads or sequins)
 - ✓ If the shirt contains tails, they must be tucked in
- ❖ If the shirt bottom is cut straight across it does not need to be tucked in but it must be long enough to come to the middle of the hip
- ❖ **Polo Shirt** - with collar and at least 2 buttons - White, Maroon, Navy Blue, Light Blue, Pale Pink or Light Grey
 - ✓ These shirts do not have to be tucked in for girls, but it is preferable
 - ✓ No bare midriffs (if midriff shows when hands are raised, the shirt should not be worn)

Elementary School Standardized Dress Code

1st - 5th Grades 2006 - 2007

- ❖ Pants and shirt may not be oversized or tight fitting and chest must be appropriately covered
- ❖ During colder seasons, a supplementary turtle neck, long sleeve polo, fleece, or sweater in an approved solid color is approved. Sweaters and fleece must be a solid color without print (store logo may not exceed 1.5" by 1.5" in diameter)

All students

- ❖ All pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers must be made of cotton-twill material. They may not be corduroy, jersey knit, or denim.
- ❖ At no time should undergarments be visible
- ❖ Hats, sunglasses, pagers, and cellular phones may not be worn at any time.

Exclusions (these items are NOT acceptable)

- ❖ Cargo, baggies, jeans, corduroy, or tight fitting pants
- ❖ Hooded sweatshirts or hooded fleeces
- ❖ Flip flops, clogs and sandals
- ❖ Excessive wrinkles in clothing
- ❖ Any color outside of the approved colors
- ❖ Tattoos - students who choose to get a tattoo on a visible part of the body while enrolled at CCA will be subject to dismissal
- ❖ Body piercings
- ❖ Outlandish hairstyles
- ❖ Boys hair that covers the ear completely, touches the collar or covers the face
- ❖ Changing into non-standard clothing while on school property unless directed by a teacher, coach, or administrator for a specific school related activity

Accessories / Trends

- ❖ On the above shirts mentioned, a store logo may not be larger than 1.5" by 1.5" in diameter
- ❖ Shoes are to be worn at all times on the school property. Tennis shoes, sneakers, tie shoes and loafers are acceptable. Dress style open-toed shoes are acceptable for 9th-12th grade girls only (heels may not be higher than 2")
- ❖ Socks that are compatible and not clashing with the attire are acceptable
- ❖ Complementary and non-distracting jewelry for girls is acceptable
- ❖ Young men are to be clean shaven
- ❖ Long sleeve solid color shirts worn under shirts must fit into the standardized colors. However, two shirts with a collar on them cannot be worn at the same time.
- ❖ The administration reserves the right to make changes and clarify statements as trends arise.

Physical Education Attire

- ❖ The elementary school (grades K - 5th) must have tennis shoes on the days they attend Physical Education. Since we do not have a boys or girls locker room, students are encouraged to wear blue jeans or the approved shorts and a CCA logo t-shirt for gym class.
